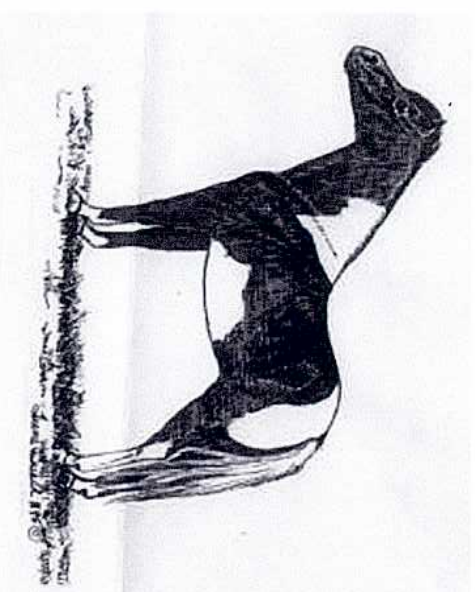

What is a Falabella?

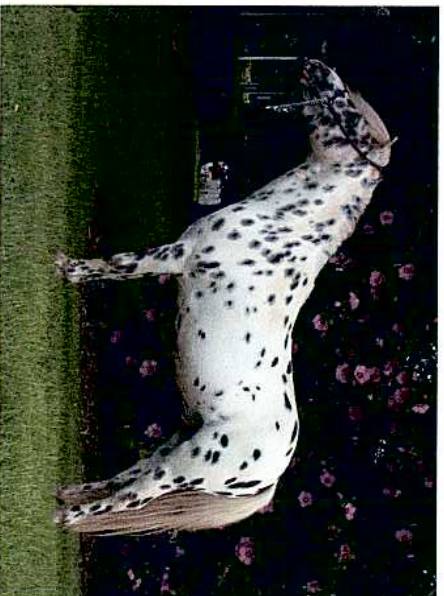
The Falabella Miniature Horse is the only recognized breed of Miniature Horse in Argentina. The Falabella family has been breeding these horses since the 1800's and they are kept pure on the Falabella Ranch and exported worldwide. All Falabellas can trace their pedigree back to Argentina.

Is there a Registry for Falabellas?

A registry was established in the United States in 1973 to keep records of the PURE Falabellas all over the world. It is considered "the original miniature horse" which many of today's American and European Miniature horses can be trace their pedigrees back to.

What is the FBOS ?



The Falabella Breeders and Owners Society (FBOS) was established in 2000 to bring the owners together to help promote and preserve the rare and PURE Falabella. It has enabled the breeders to keep in contact and exchange important history and pedigree information no matter where the breeder may be located worldwide. It is the only such club for PURE Falabellas.

The Purpose of the FBOS?

To encourage the PURE breeding of Falabellas and have them recorded with the Falabella Miniature Horse Association; as well as promote, protect and preserve these horses as a PURE breed.
